1. Assessment

Descriptive, structural, and dynamic evaluation of personality pathology: Clinical interviews, self-reports, and Ecological Momentary Assessment

2. Treatment and treatment efficacy

3. Basic research

Social cognition, neurosciences, and neurobehavioral basis of personality disorders

4. Adolescence

Development and stabilization of personality during adolescence, etiology of PDs, and longitudinal studies

5. Methodological course

Data analytic techniques for time-series and longitudinal data
